

Did Judas Eat the Full Passover Meal?

I. John 13:2-5

“And supper being ended, the devil having now put into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's son, to betray him; Jesus knowing that the Father had given all things into his hands, and that he was come from God, and went to God; He riseth from supper, and laid aside his garments; and took a towel, and girded himself. After that he poureth water into a bason, and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel wherewith he was girded.”

A. Jesus states not all the disciples are clean. He was referring to Judas who would soon betray Him.

1. He was letting disciples know what was going to happen
2. He was still giving Judas an option to repent

II. John 13:25-27

“He then lying on Jesus' breast saith unto him, Lord, who is it? (John asked) Jesus answered, He it is, to whom I shall give a sop, when I have dipped it. And when he had dipped the sop, he gave it to Judas Iscariot, the son of Simon. And after the sop Satan entered into him. Then said Jesus unto him, That thou doest, do quickly.

A. **Matthew 26:25** “Then Judas, which betrayed him, answered and said, Master, is it I? He said unto him, Thou hast said.”

1. When Judas leaves Jesus institutes the New Covenant with the 11 disciples. He did not have communion with Judas.

B. Jesus identified Judas Iscariot will betray him to Sanhedrin.

C. Ok to still shop for Passover Meals and the Feast of Unleavened bread.

III. Luke 22:19-20 - The Passover Night

19 And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake it, and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me. 20 Likewise also the cup after supper, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood, which is shed for you.

A. The 14th of Nissan starting at sundown.

B. At Mark's home

C. In the Old Testament - Eat the lamb – where the blood had been put on the doorpost, and unleavened bread for their healing.

1. Jesus is our lamb slain for our redemption.

D. Peter and John go to the temple and have killed the lamb in the afternoon for the meal.

1. **I Peter 1:18-19** “Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.”

2. Unleavened bread (Body of Christ with no sin)

3. Look back to Passover in Egypt

E. **Exodus 12:13** “The blood shall be a sign for you upon the houses where you are, I shall see the blood and I shall Passover you, there shall not be a plague of destruction upon you when I strike the land.”

F. When the death angel came it hit those who were not in Blood Covenant and those eating unleavened bread for healing.

IV. Matthew 27:3-5 “Then Judas, which had betrayed him, when he saw that he was condemned, repented himself, and brought again the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders, Saying, I have sinned in that I have betrayed the innocent blood. And they said, What is that to us? see thou to that. And he cast down the pieces of silver in the temple, and departed, and went and hanged himself.”

A. Judas was not privileged to take of communion so the death angel took him.

B. Today when believers take communion, we remember His sacrifice for our redemption and are passed over from destruction because of his blood/body of Christ.
