I. Angels

- A. **Hebrews 1:14** “Are they not all ministering spirits sent forth to minister (Greek – services) for them who shall be heirs of salvation.
- B. Angels – service believers who ask Jesus for help
- C. At the First Advent, there was a constant flow of angels and prophecy
 - 1. It will be the same in the last days

II. Joseph - 4 Visitations In Dreams

- A. 4 Visitations
 - 1. **Matthew 1:20** “20But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost.”
 - 2. **Matthew 1:24** “24Then Joseph being raised from sleep did as the angel of the Lord had bidden him, and took unto him his wife:”
 - 3. **Matthew 2:12-13** “12And being warned of God in a dream that they should not return to Herod, they departed into their own country another way. 13And when they were departed, behold, the angel of the Lord appeareth to Joseph in a dream, saying, Arise, and take the young child and his mother, and flee into Egypt, and be thou there until I bring thee word: for Herod will seek the young child to destroy him.”
 - 4. **Matthew 2:19-20** “19But when Herod was dead, behold, an angel of the Lord appeareth in a dream to Joseph in Egypt, 20Saying, Arise, and take the young child and his mother, and go into the land of Israel: for they are dead which sought the young child's life.”
- B. Joseph's instruction for his family came by Angel's visitation in dreams

III. Zechariah

A. In the Temple, angel appears

1. **Luke 1:11-13** “11And there appeared unto him an angel of the Lord standing on the right side of the altar of incense. 12And when Zacharias saw him, he was troubled, and fear fell upon him. 13But the angel said unto him, Fear not, Zacharias: for thy prayer is heard; and thy wife Elisabeth shall bear thee a son, and thou shalt call his name John.
2. **Luke 1:19-20** “19And the angel answering said unto him, I am Gabriel, that stand in the presence of God; and am sent to speak unto thee, and to shew thee these glad tidings. 20And, behold, thou shalt be dumb, and not able to speak, until the day that these things shall be performed, because thou believest not my words, which shall be fulfilled in their season.”

B. In his home after John's birth

1. **Luke 1:67-69** “67And his father Zacharias was filled with the Holy Ghost, and prophesied, saying, 68Blessed be the Lord God of Israel; for he hath visited and redeemed his people, 69And hath raised up an horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David;”

IV. Mary, Mother of Jesus

Luke 1:28-35 – Angel's visit

“28And the angel came in unto her, and said, Hail, thou that art highly favoured, the Lord is with thee: blessed art thou among women. 29And when she saw him, she was troubled at his saying, and cast in her mind what manner of salutation this should be. 30And the angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for thou hast found favour with God. 31And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name Jesus. 32He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David: 33And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end. 34Then said Mary unto the angel, How shall this be, seeing I know not a man? 35And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God.”

Luke 1:46-48 – prophesied

“**46**And Mary said, My soul doth magnify the Lord, **47**And my spirit hath rejoiced in God my Saviour. **48**For he hath regarded the low estate of his handmaiden: for, behold, from henceforth all generations shall call me blessed.”

V. Elizabeth – John The Baptist' Mother – prophesied

Luke 1:42-45 – prophesied

“**42**And she spake out with a loud voice, and said, Blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb. **43**And whence is this to me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me? **44**For, lo, as soon as the voice of thy salutation sounded in mine ears, the babe leaped in my womb for joy. **45**And blessed is she that believed: for there shall be a performance of those things which were told her from the Lord.”
