

## Moses: Disobedience vs Obedience

### I. The Ten Plagues

- A. **1<sup>st</sup> Plague** – The Nile turns to blood and all water in Egypt, seven days, fish die.

**Result** – Pharaoh hardened his heart.

- B. **2<sup>nd</sup> Plague** – Frogs all over Egypt.

**Result** – Pharaoh hardened his heart.

- C. **3<sup>rd</sup> Plague** – Gnats and lice on men and beast.

**Result** – Pharaoh hardened his heart.

- D. **4<sup>th</sup> Plague** – Flies and insects (roaches, ticks, spiders, bees, mosquitoes) all over Egypt.

**Result** – Goshen protected, Pharaoh hardened his heart.

- E. **5<sup>th</sup> Plague** – All livestock in the field killed (cattle, donkeys, camels, oxen, sheep) = meat supply.

**Result** – Goshen protected, Pharaoh hardened his heart.

- F. **6<sup>th</sup> Plague** – Boils on men and beast.

**Result** – Goshen protected, Pharaoh hardened his heart.

- G. **7<sup>th</sup> Plague** – Hail and fire falls on all trees, vegetables, men or animals in the field.

**Result** – Goshen protected, Pharaoh hardened his heart.

- H. **8<sup>th</sup> Plague** – Locust eat everything left in the fields (starvation of Egypt).

**Result** – Goshen protected, Pharaoh hardened his heart.

I. **9<sup>th</sup> Plague** – Darkness you could feel for three days.

Result – Goshen protected, Pharaoh hardened his heart.

J. **Obedience of Goshen** – borrow silver and gold of all the people of Egypt.

**Proverbs 1:7** “The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge.”

K. **10<sup>th</sup> Plague** – Firstborn of Egyptians will die.

## **II. Obedience Of The Children Of Israel**

A. Buy a lamb on 10<sup>th</sup> of Nisan.

B. Kill lamb on the 14<sup>th</sup> of Nisan.

C. Put blood on your doorpost of your house.

D. Afterward, close your door and eat lamb roasted with unleavened bread, dress to leave the land.

E. When I see the blood I will Passover you.
