

## The Hidden Miracles

### I. Matthew 9:26-33

<sup>26</sup> And the fame hereof went abroad into all that land. <sup>27</sup> And when Jesus departed thence, two blind men followed him, crying, and saying, Thou son of David, have mercy on us. <sup>28</sup> And when he was come into the house, the blind men came to him: and Jesus saith unto them, Believe ye that I am able to do this? They said unto him, Yea, Lord. <sup>29</sup> Then touched he their eyes, saying, According to your faith be it unto you. <sup>30</sup> And their eyes were opened; and Jesus straitly charged them, saying, See that no man know it. <sup>31</sup> But they, when they were departed, spread abroad his fame in all that country. <sup>32</sup> As they went out, behold, they brought to him a dumb man possessed with a devil. <sup>33</sup> And when the devil was cast out, the dumb spake: and the multitudes marvelled, saying, It was never so seen in Israel.

- A. Jesus had raised Jairus' daughter from the dead.
- B. Jesus returned to Peter's home in Capernaum.
- C. Followed into the house (uninvited)
  - 1. 2 blind men – asking for their healing
  - 2. On the way out – a dumb man possessed, slips into the house. Jesus delivers him and he receives his healing.

### II. Demanding People Who Received Their Healing

- A. Desperate people who got their healing
  - 1. The leper healed – on the road asked Jesus, “if thou will, thou can make me whole.” (Mark 1:40-41)
  - 2. The paralytic lowered through the roof by four of his friends. “Rise take up your bed and walk.” (Mark 2)
  - 3. The Syro-Phoenician woman's daughter healed – after she broke into the house and begged for one crumb of healing. (Matthew 15)

4. The woman with the issue of blood – touched the hem of his garment and was healed. (Mark 5)

### **III. What Do They All Have In Common**

- A. They were desperate to be healed.
- B. Broke through the crowd to be touched by Jesus.
- C. Made a demand on Jesus' anointing.
- D. Let their faith go out for healing when they stood before Jesus.
